Ripening time	early, same ripening time as 'Orangenaprikose'
Scale, shape	medium to large, globose to ovoid, limited suture
Colour	intensive orange ground colour, 50-70 % light to medium red, shiny over colour
Fruit flesh	intense orange, finely textured, very juicy
Taste	typical apricot flavour, as the fruit ripens the sourness of the fruit skin dissipates
Stone separability	freestone
Storage	good
Tree:	
Vigour	medium strong, spreading to pendulous
Crop load	from early age ideal to high, a medium strong fruit thinning is sufficient
Evaluation	<p>This early ripening, self-fertile Apricot guarantees regular and high yields. The very attractive fruits are well sized among high productivity. The fruit flesh is remarkably firm.</p> <p>The susceptibility to ESFY should be considered for choice of site.</p> <p>A minimum order of 25 trees per fruit grower is required.</p>
