Blooming date, -intensity	early blossom period, ideal blossom density
Fertility	self-fertile
Frost susceptibility	low to medium

Ripening time	medium late, about 6 days before 'Bergeron'
Scale, shape	medium, ellipsoid flat shaped, deep suture
Colour	intense orange ground colour, 40-60 % red to dark red over colour
Fruit flesh	intense orange, firm, very juicy
Taste	sweet-aromatic
Cracking sensitivity	low
Stone separability	freestone
Plum pox	tolerant
Storage	good

Vigour	medium strong, upright, moderate branching
Crop load	medium high, tends to biennial bearing and fruit drop
Evaluation	This self-fertile variety ripens medium late and has attractive, firm fruits that have a sweet-aromatic taste. A high sugar content makes this variety suitable for distilling.
