Frost susceptibility	low to medium susceptibility of flower buds to winter frost

Ripening time	early, 3-6 days before 'Orangenaprikose'
Scale, shape	medium to large, rounded
Colour	yellow orange ground colour, 30-60 % shiny light red over colour
Fruit flesh	intense orange, firm, juicy
Taste	intense apricot flavour with balanced acidity in the skin
Cracking sensitivity	low
Stone separability	freestone
Storage	good
Tree:	
Vigour	medium strong, tends to spreading, very even branching
Crop load	from an early age high and regular
Evaluation	Very attractive, high-yielding variety that ripens early. Good fruit sizes and excellent flavour can be achieved by thorough fruit thinning. Furthermore PINK MARRY™ qualifies as an excellent pollinator for 'Orangenaprikose'.
