Blooming date, -intensity	medium-late blossom period with high density
Fertility	self-fertile
Flower shape	rose shape
Frost susceptibility	low to medium susceptibility of the flower buds to winter frost damage
Fruit:	
Ripening time	medium-late, 10.-11. peach week
Scale, shape	medium to large, globose, significant suture, slightly asymmetrical half-fruits
Skin	smooth-skinned and firm
Colour	yellow orange ground colour, up to 90 % red to dark red over colour, fruits colour sufficiently in the shade
Fruit flesh	intense yellow, melting flesh when fully ripe, very juicy
Taste	fine but slightly sourish taste
Stone separability	freestone
Storage	good to very good, travels well
Tree:	
Vigour	medium to strong, semi-upright to spreading, good branching, good tree health
Crop load	high and regular productivity
Evaluation:	Fantasia is an old and proven yellow-fleshed nectarine variety with high yield, attractive appearance and typical flavour.
