Current rootstock for peaches and nectarines for commercial orchards in Germany

Vigour: 70-80% compared to peach seedling RUBIRA™

Origin: Trial station La Grande Ferrade, Bordeaux, France, 1962

Lineage: St. Julien A from Orleans x Prunus domestica 'Pershore'

Characteristics: Medium to strong growing rootstock with an upright habit. Despite the strong growth this rootstock is very fertile and supports an early yield beginning. The trees have a very good lodging resistance.

Spacing: $2 - 2.5 \text{ m} \times 3.5 - 4.5 \text{ m}$

Site: This rootstock is adjusted to many different soil and climate conditions. Also suitable for heavy and wet soils. Chlorosis can occur from a pH level of 8 or higher. A production of root suckers is possible depending on the site.
