## **JULIOR™ Ferdor**

Current rootstock for peaches and nectarines for commercial orchards in Germany

**Vigour:** 70-80% compared to peach seedling RUBIRA™

**Origin:** Trial station La Grande Ferrade, Bordeaux, France, 1962

**Lineage:** St. Julien A from Orleans x *Prunus domestica* 'Persshore'

**Characteristics:** Medium to strong growing rootstock with an upright habit. Despite the strong growth this rootstock is very fertile and supports an early yield beginning. The trees have a very good lodging resistance.

**Spacing:** 2 - 2,5 m x 3,5 - 4,5 m

**Site:** This rootstock is adjusted to many different soil and climate conditions. Also suitable for heavy and wet soils. Chlorosis can occur from a pH level of 8 or higher. A production of root suckers is possible depending on the site.
