Variety: Oullins Reneklode (Golden Gage)

Species: Gage, *Prunus domestica*

Breeder, Place	commercial variety of nurseryman Massot in Oullins near Lyon, imported to Germany in 1860
Parents	unknown, found in France in the early 19. century
Property rights	free variety
Blossom:	
Blooming date	medium early
Fertility	self-fertile, good pollinator
Fruit:	
Ripening time	medium, 6. plum week, slightly uneven ripening
Scale, shape	medium to large, 43-46 mm, 40-55 g, globose
Colour	yellowish with wax bloom
Fruit flesh	yellowish, medium firm, very juicy, firm skin
Taste	spicy-sweet, depending on timely fruit-thinning
Cracking sensitivity	low to medium, susceptible to Monilia
Stone separability	partial freestone
Plum pox	tolerant
Storage	limited storage and transport
Tree:	
Vigour	strong growth, semi-upright to spreading, tends to blind wood
Crop load	from an early age, ideal to high
Evaluation:	Classic and well-known gage variety, which is suitable for farm shops and direct sales. Appreciated for the very juicy, sweet and spicy fruit flesh.
