Fruit:	
Ripening time	3.-4. cherry week, 20 days before 'Schattenmorelle', regular ripening
Scale, shape	24-26 mm, 7-8 g, obloid, medium long stalk
Colour	light to medium red
Fruit flesh	pink red, soft to medium firm, Durofel pressure 25: 32-35, very juicy, lightly coloured juice
Taste	spicy with balanced acidity
Cracking sensitivity	medium to high
Stalk detachment	very poor
Tree:	
Vigour	medium strong, widely spreading, dense crown, not prone to blind wood, very good fruit to leaf ratio
Crop load	medium
Evaluation:	The early ripening, fairly large fruits with mild taste make this variety suitable for the fresh market and especially for the beginning of the season. The fruits are used primarily as topping on cakes.
