<b>Evaluation:</b>	<p>Interesting variety in the early ripening period!</p> <p>The attractive, large fruits have very good firmness and are easy to pick. A final evaluation of this variety and its susceptibility to bacterial canker is not possible yet because of the short testing period. Right now it is only recommended for best sites.</p> <p>If you are interested to plant CERASINA™-varieties outside of the Netherlands or Germany we need the authorisation of the license holder.</p>
