Fruit:	
Ripening time	medium, 5. cherry week, in the average 20 days after 'Burlat'
Scale, shape	large, 28-30 mm, 11-13 g, kidney- to heart-shaped with obtuse apex, medium long to long, robust green stalks
Colour	blushed cherry
Fruit flesh	creamy, firm and crisp, Durofel pressure 25: 70-75 at full maturity, very juicy
Taste	aromatic with very well balanced sugar-acid ratio, without bitterness, 18 Brix at full maturity
Cracking sensitivity	low
Storage	good, the stalks remain fresh and green

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Tree:	
Vigour	medium strong, compact without blind wood, semi-upright to spreading, very good branching, very well suitable for central leader system, healthy leaves and wood
Crop load	Every year ideal to high production with very good fruit-size. The fruits are hanging densely without clusters. Because of the long stalks the picking rate is very high.
Evaluation:	PAPILLON™ Pillangó (S) is a blushed sweet cherry with a long harvesting period that ripens in the 5. cherry week. Special characteristics are the high cracking resistance, low susceptibility to bruising through wind damage as well as intense flavour and finely textured fruit flesh. Furthermore the good healthiness of the tree and foliage has convinced.
