Property rights	free variety
<b>Blossom:</b>	
Blooming date	early to medium early
Fertility	self-fertile, good pollinator
<b>Fruit:</b>	
Ripening time	medium early, 5. plum week, maturity date 10-14 days after colouring
Scale, shape	medium to large, 36-42 mm, 32-48 g, ellipsoid
Colour	even dark blue with heavy bloom
Fruit flesh	light green, firm
Taste	at the first pick flavour can be poor but well developed at full maturity
Cracking sensitivity	low
Stone separability	freestone
Plum pox	less susceptible
Storage	travels and storages well when picked early
<b>Tree:</b>	
Vigour	medium strong growth, moderate branching, tends to spreading, good leaf to fruit ratio, highly susceptible to Monilia and less to Valsa
Crop load	high-yielding variety from an early age
<b>Evaluation:</b>	This variety reaches high commercial value because of its high and regular yields. The yield potential and the large fruits guarantee a high tonnage. Because of that Cacaks Schöne is the most efficient variety right now for the baking industry. Important to mention is the early colouring of the fruits, usually up to 10-14 days before good aroma develops. An early harvest is not recommended.
