Blooming date	very early to early

Fruit:	
Ripening time	medium late, 8.-9. plum week, just before 'Hauszwetschge'
Scale, shape	medium to large, 34-40 mm, 30-40 g, ellipsoid
Colour	even dark blue with bloom, shaded fruits slightly rufescent
Fruit flesh	golden, orange coloured at full maturity, firm, medium juicy
Taste	well flavoured when fully ripe
Cracking sensitivity	low
Stone separability	freestone when fully ripe
Plum pox	tolerant
Storage	good
Tree:	
Vigour	weak growth, very compact, very good branching, short branches with dark green, shiny and healthy foliage
Crop load	from an early age high, tends to overcropping
Evaluation:	This self-fertile variety ripening just before 'Hauszwetschge' is impressive for its high and regular yield from the beginning. Haroma (S) is suitable for fresh eating and baking.
