Ripening time	early, 2. plum week, between 'Herman' and 'Katinka (S)'
Scale, shape	Ø 28 - 30 mm, ovoid
Colour	evenly blue coloured, heavy bloom
Fruit flesh	greenish yellow, very juicy, finely textured when fully ripe
Taste	well balanced sugar-acid ratio
Stone separability	freestone
Plum pox	tolerant (according to breeder)
Tree:	
Vigour	medium strong, semi-upright to spreading, good branching
Crop load	from an early age high and regular, to high crop load leads to small fruit size
Evaluation:	Early ripening plum with excellent fresh market and baking qualities. The very evenly ripening fruits can be picked in two rounds when there was thorough fruit-thinning.
