Vigour	medium strong, semi-upright to spreading, well branched, dark green and healthy leaves
Crop load	early setting, ideal to high
<b>Evaluation:</b>	Walters Herrenberger™ is a late-ripening plum variety whose most notable characteristic is its absolute immunity to the plum pox virus. The spicy, aromatic fruit is used for baking and desserts as well as for industrial processing.
